



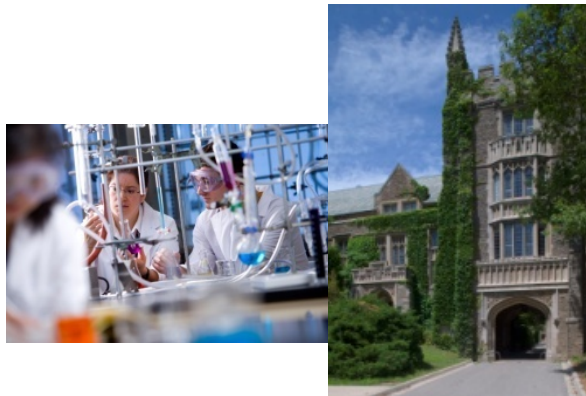
## Summer English Program with eHealth Focus
