- CAE/CPE score of B2 and higher

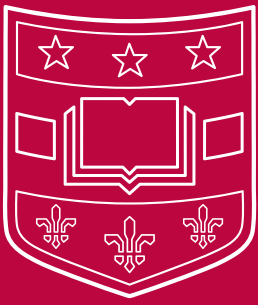

## PROGRAM FEE AND SCHOLARSHIPS\*

The program fee is \$7,995. The fee includes:

- Tuition and lab fees for two courses (up to 7 units of credit)
- Access to campus libraries, the Writing Center, and student services
- Housing in an air-conditioned campus residence hall
- Meal stipend to use at restaurants both on and off campus
- Social and cultural activities both on and off campus
- Private sessions with university deans, directors, and admissions counselors
- A designated U.S. student host (your PEER Mentor)
- Transportation pass for St. Louis bus and light rail system
- Health insurance
